In ~~these circumstances~~ the Congress received both the Report of the International Commission and the Order-in-Council with strong repudiation because both these documents entitle the Jews to perform their worship and religious devotions in this Moslem Holy Place and to place therein articles of worship and religious appurtenances, and at the same time, prevent Moslems from the free exercise of their proprietary right and right of worship in this place and in its surroundings in such a manner as they may desire. The Congress further considers the Report as prejudicial to Moslem rights, religious as well as civil, and inconsistent with the Sharia Law and official documents in possession of Moslems. The Congress has instructed the President thereof to convey its opinion, as stated, to the competent authorities and to stress the necessity for the reconsideration of this question and the safeguarding of established Moslem ^{interest} ~~rights~~ which could not be subjected to any qualification or condition incompatible with Moslem Sharia Law, practise, usage or established proprietary rights.
