Dear Sir,

With reference to the question placed by the visitors in the Church Council at Nazareth in respect of the C. M. S. schools in Palestine, I beg to make the following proposition with regard to the Girls Schools of Jerusalem:-

1. A grant of £ 150 per annum to be given for a period of five years.
2. After five years the grant to be reduced annually at the rate of 5%.
3. A lady to take charge of the work will be nominated by the temporary committee (on behalf of whom I am writing which Committee undertake to pay the deficit) and the nomination will be approved by the standing Committee.
4. The Head-Mistress will later on nominate a Trust Board (functions as per 5 below) which Board will be approved by your committee.
5. Functions of this Board:-
 - a. Approving of teachers nominated by Headmistress.
 - b. Approving the curriculum as submitted by Headmistress.
 - c. Approving the method of annual examination as prepared by the Headmistress.
6. The school will charge fees not to exceed:-
£ 6 per annum for the upper classes,
£ 3 " " for kindergarten "
- This may be exceeded as soon as the grant begins to be reduced.
7. There will be a teacher for every 20 pupils .
8. Boys up to age of 12 will be accepted.
- 9½ The Lady in charge will have the right to cancel this agreement at the end of the second and third years.
10. Further details and amendments will, if the scheme is agreed to in principle, be discussed.
11. A definite reply is required by the end of June 1924

I take this opportunity to assure you that our purpose is to serve the country by giving the girls a sound and useful Christian Education. Special endeavours will be made to enrol as many Mohd. girls as possible.
